#### D. Elections for Committee / Task Force Elections

Chair Mickey Bradley informed Board members that are current Chairs of their respective committees to update him via email to provide their preference in the future to fill available committee positions. Silence as consent to remain.

## E. Report from the Government Law Center (GLC)

Maureen Obie reported that as of today, May 21, 2017, there are 13 active complaints. Of those, 3 were reviewed this evening, and 2 were closed with no review, leaving 11 complaints. A total of 734 complaints have been closed, including 40 complaints that have been closed with no review. The total number of complaints that remain suspended from review by the Board is 2. The total number of complaints filed to date is 747. Since the Board's last meeting on March 9, the GLC received 4 Grievance Forms, leaving the total number of forms received at 616.

Ms. Obie reported that the GLC continues to conduct research internally and externally better options for data storage management. Information pertaining to other citizen police oversight organizations' administrative handling of complaints received from emotionally disturbed person (EDPs) nationally is also currently being researched.

The GLC will move forward on expanded outreach efforts proposed to the Board, including a postcard promo mailing, distribution of informational flyers, and increasing the number of complaint form locations, to include form locations that provide assistance to citizens with completing the forms.

Commander Michael Hicks reported that there were no updates at this time.
